## Acts 2:1-4

Thanksgiving over the Water

Pastor: The Lord be with you. **People: And also with you.** 

Pastor: Let us pray. Eternal Father: When nothing existed but chaos, you swept across the dark waters and brought forth light. In the days of Noah you saved those on the ark through water. After the flood you set in the clouds a rainbow. When you saw your people as slaves in Egypt, you led them to freedom through the sea.
